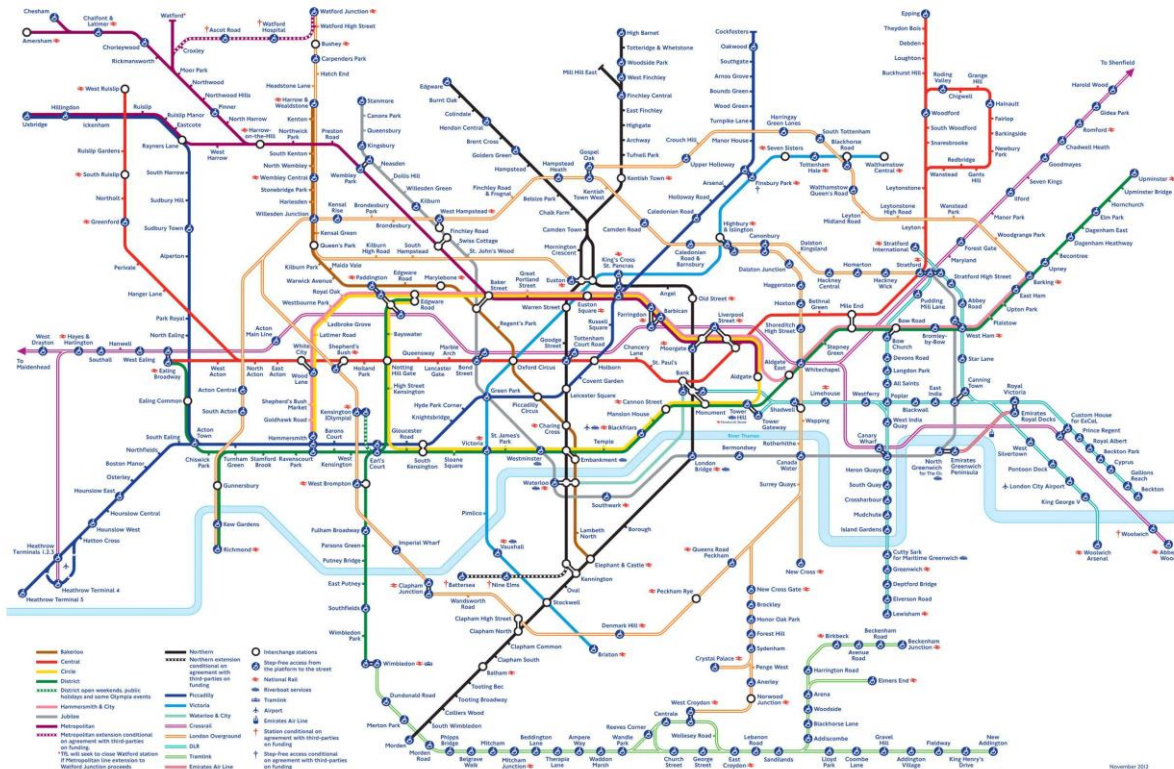


Paddington Bear, Sherlock Holmes and the Tube

Paddington and Sherlock Holmes are talking about the directions for their sightseeing tour.

Read what they are saying:

Sherlock:

Look at this Tube map, Paddington: Now we are at Paddington Station and we are going to go to Buckingham Palace. The nearest Tube station is St. James Park. What is the best way to get there?

Paddington:

First we take the Hammersmith & City Line eastbound to Aldgate East. There we change to the District Line and take it westbound to St. James Park.

Sherlock:

But that's a very long way! Look, Paddington, there is an easier way to get there. It is easy and short.

We are at Paddington again and we just take the Circle Line southbound to St. James Park where we get off.

Paddington and Sherlock Holmes on their way to Madame Tussauds

Read what they are saying and follow their way on the map.

Paddington:

Well, I really liked The Guards in front of Buckingham Palace. Next we are going to go to Madame Tussauds, aren't we? Now, Sherlock, what is the best way to get there?

Sherlock:

We are at St. James Park now. Baker Street is the nearest Tube station to Madame Tussauds. We can take the Circle Line westbound to Baker Street.

Paddington:

But that is boring, Sherlock! I like the Tube. I think I can find a more interesting way! Let me see. Oh yes!

We take the Circle Line or the District Line eastbound to Westminster. Then we change to the Jubilee Line and take it northbound. We get off at Baker Street and walk to Madame Tussauds.

Paddington and Sherlock Holmes on their way to The Tower

After Madame Tussauds Paddington and Sherlock Holmes are going to visit The Tower to see the Crown Jewels. Tower Hill is the nearest Tube station. Explain the way on the Tube to them.

Paddington and Sherlock on their way to Covent Garden

Paddington and Sherlock Holmes on their way to the Tower - Key

1. We take the Circle Line to Tower Hill.
2. We take the Bakerloo Line southbound to Embankment. Then we change to the Circle Line or the District Line eastbound to Tower Hill.

Paddington on his way to Covent Garden- Key

We take the Circle Line or the District Line westbound to Embankment where we change to the Northern Line. We take the Northern Line northbound to Leicester Square where we change again. (Finally) we take the Piccadilly Line northbound to Covent Garden.
